The following list identifies those trading partners which have allowed full or partial trade in Canadian beef based on official approval of Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) certification.

3. Azerbaijan - All beef
(Note: There are currently no approved Canadian establishments)

7. Cayman Islands - Beef from animals under 30 months of age, offal from animals under 30 months of age, all liver

9. China - Beef (boneless and bone-in), excluding offal, from animals under 30 months of age

12. Cuba - All beef and offal (except tongues and hearts)
13. Egypt - Beef from animals under 30 months of age, offal from animals under 30 months of age
14. El Salvador - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age
(Note: There are currently no approved Canadian establishments)

15. European Union (27)¹- All beef and offal
16. Georgia -All beef and offal
17. Guatemala -All beef
(Note: There are currently no approved Canadian establishments)
18. Honduras - All beef
19. Hong Kong - All beef
20. Indonesia - Boneless beef excluding offal
21. Iceland - All beef (EU requirements)
22. Jamaica - All beef
(Note: According to industry, importers have faced difficulties obtaining import permits)
23. Japan - All beef
24. Jordan - All beef
25. Kazakhstan - All boneless beef; bone-in beef from animals under 30 months of age (Russia requirements)
26. Kuwait -All beef
27. Lebanon - Boneless beef from animals under thirty months of age and offal
28. Macau - All beef and offal
29. Macedonia - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age, offal from animals under 30 months of age
30. Mexico - All beef, offal, liver

¹ European Union (27): Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovak Republic, Slovenia, Spain, and Sweden.

- 36. Peru - All boneless beef; bone-in beef from animals under 30 months of age; offal with no age restrictions (tongue, heart, ruminant stomach, liver and kidneys)
- 37. Philippines - All beef and offal
- 38. Puerto Rico - All beef and offal (U.S. certification requirements apply)
- 39. Qatar - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age
- 40. Russia - All boneless beef; bone-in beef from animals under 30 months of age
(Note: Since August 7, 2014, Russia has imposed an embargo on importation of certain agricultural products, including beef, from countries including Canada, the U.S., EU member states, Australia and Norway, that have imposed economic sanctions on Russia.)
- 41. St. Kitts & Nevis - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age
- 42. St. Pierre et Miquelon - All beef
- 43. Saudi Arabia - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age
- 44. Singapore - All boneless beef; bone-in beef from animals under 30 months of age
- 45. South Korea - Beef from animals under 30 months of age, includes offal.

- 46. Switzerland - All beef and offal (EU requirements)
- 47. Taiwan - Beef from animals under 30 months of age, includes specified offal
- 48. Thailand - Boneless beef from animals under 30 months of age, excludes offal
- 49. Trinidad & Tobago - Beef from animals under 30 months of age, liver from animals under 30 months
- 50. Tunisia - Beef from animals under 30 months of age
- 51. Ukraine - Beef from animals under 30 months of age

- 53. United Kingdom - All beef and offal (EU requirements)
